ELIGIBILITY

Artists are invited to submit up to three works. Entries must have been completed within the last two years and have not been entered in any previous CAA show. Approximately 60 works will be chosen for hanging.

CATEGORIES

Watercolor

Oils/Acrylics

Mixed Media: Pastel, ink, mixed monotype, graphics, two or more different media.

We will not accept three dimensional work or photography

REQUIREMENTS

All work must be original and created by a living artist, 18 years or older. Please bring your work exhibit-ready, framed, hard-wired and ready for hanging. All work must be accompanied by a completed entry slip and agent/artist must present artist receipt to pick up work. Work may not exceed 38 inches in any dimension including frame. The CAA reserves the right to refuse a work that cannot be appropriately accommodated or that is not ready for hanging. An art category must meet a minimum number of entries in order to qualify for a prize.

SUBMISSION OF WORK

All work must be hand-delivered by the artist/agent to the CAA building, 98 Hayden Rowe Street on Friday, April 9 between 4 - 7 pm or Saturday, April 10 between 4 - 7.

NON-REFUNDABLE FEE

Artist fee for submitting up to 3 pieces of work:
Members Fee \$25 Non-members \$35

SALES

Retail sales are encouraged. A 20% commission will be deducted from all sales and will benefit the CAA.

PICKUP

Artists will be e-mailed only if work submitted has NOT been chosen for the exhibit.

Artists whose work is not chosen will be notified about a time to retrieve their work. A storage fee of \$10 will be charged if work is not claimed properly or timely.

LIABILITY

Entry of artwork in the exhibition constitutes an agreement by the artist that the work may be photographed and that the CAA may use the photo for any publicity purposes without remuneration to the artist. All entries are submitted at the risk of the entrant. The CAA shall not be liable for any loss or damage to any artwork occurring while that work is in the possession of the CAA. Arrangements for insurance, if any, covering artwork submitted shall be the sole responsibility of the artist submitting the work. The CAA will exercise due care in handling all submitted work.
